Writing an argument paragraph

okay today I'm going to talk to you about how to write an argument paragraphs (you can buy this type of paper here - cheap reliable essay writing service) first off we need to talk about what argument writing actually is when you are writing an argumentative essay you're required to investigate a topic collect generate and evaluate evidence and establish a position on the topic in a concise manner here's the structure that you will follow for writing your argument paragraph it is called the strong answer format first off you start with a claim or a thesis this is what you're going to argue throughout the entire paragraph okay it is the point that you are trying to make following that you're going to include evidence evidence or data that is going to support your claim and it needs to be relevant it has to be specific and it has to be textually based so we're going to be looking for direct quotes from the text following that you then have to analyze your evidence so this is called the warrant this is where you explain how your evidence supports your claim and then lastly ending your paragraph you need a nice strong conclusion ending with the zinger sentence that really summarizes your claim and leaves a lasting impression on the reader so here's an example that we're going to go through to show you those parts okay so first off you can notice that you have your header right up here okay last name and the page number so this is supposed to be MLA formatted so Times New Roman 12-point double-spaced with the header then first and last name your core and the date this one is about time travel and whether or not is there it is a risk worth taking so as you can see first off we start with a catchy title time travel does not belong in the real world then we go to our claim or our thesis time travel is not a risk worth taking due to the many complications involved with traveling through time including how it can potentially lead to an infectious disease outbreak so that is what is going to be argued throughout the rest of the paragraph now there has to be evidence to support that so in green you see the evidence a quote from the article the trouble with time travel states in many ways this is the most overlooked and most dangerous aspect of time travel the destination point future past may have diseases microbes bacteria you don't have immunity to traveling into the past or returning from the future runs the risk of introducing a disease or microbe into a time period that doesn't have the resources to handle it so that is textual evidence that is going to support the claim further on in the orange we have the analysis of the evidence this is where the author is explaining how their evidence supports their claim this proves the time travel is not a risk worth taking because if someone were to travel in time and unknowingly pick up bacteria that the present day was not immune to then an uncontrollable virulent disease would break out there would not be an immediate cure so the disease that spread rapidly and spiral out of control this means the traveling through time can wipe out all of society the risky business of tried time travel is not worth experiencing as its outcomes are drastic and life-threatening so it is taking that evidence that was provided and then just explaining it and showing how it supports the claim and then lastly it ends with a zinger sentence in blue by striking the world with plague that spreads like a wildfire perplexing the population and jeopardizing lives time travel is a tremendous risk that will never be worth taking so there is a great example we have it all in MLA format we see our catchy title we see our thesis we see our evidence in green we see our

analysis in orange and our zinger sentence the conclusion in blue so that's what we're looking for when we're talking about writing an argument paragraph that has a strong analysis so when you're writing you want to remember to write and complete sentences check your grammar spelling and punctuation so there are no errors include specific examples from the text and make sure that the example that you have actually proves your claim so you have to make sure that it relates to and is providing evidence that is supportive you also want to make sure to include those direct quotes in your evidence use MLA format again that's Times New Roman 12-point double-spaced with a header and your creative original title that relates to the content of the essay that is the argument paragraph good luck
